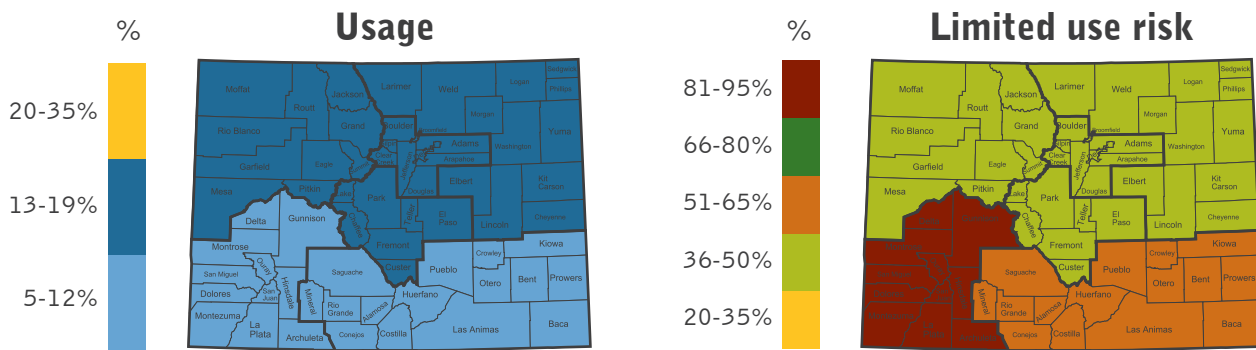


Rise Above Colorado Youth Survey - Marijuana

The Rise Above Colorado Youth Survey is a data source for behavioral health and substance use attitudes and behaviors among Colorado teens 12-17. 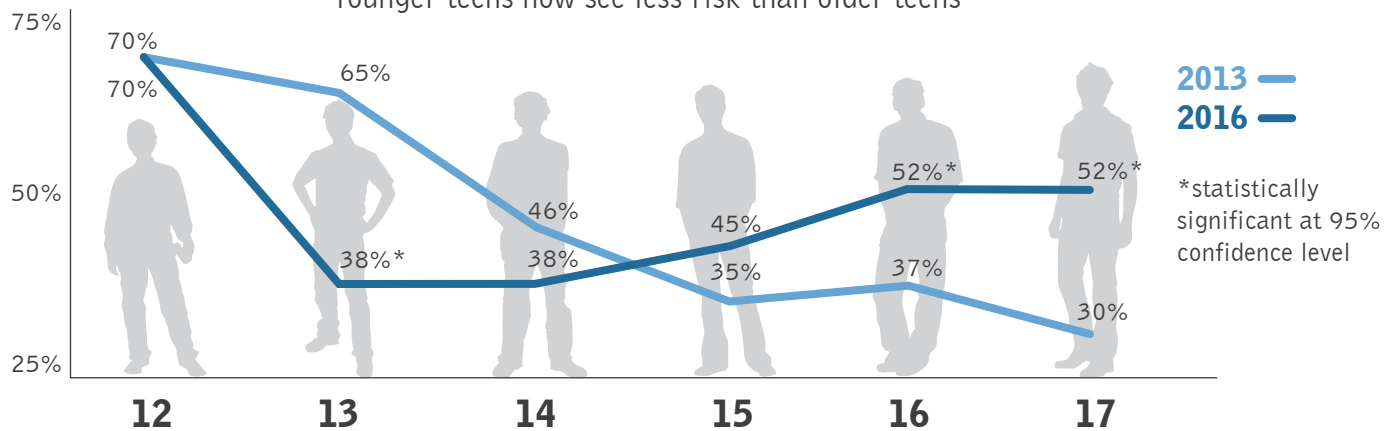
Marijuana use and perception of risk by region, 2016

There was no statistically significant change in use or risk between 2013 and 2016



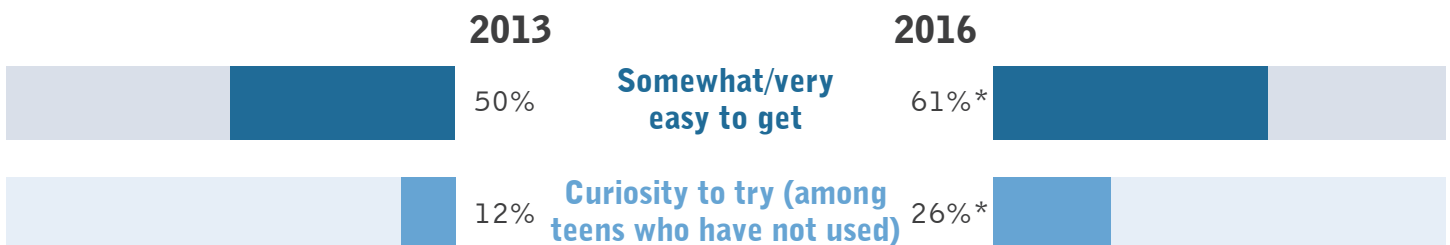
Perceived risk of limited marijuana use by age, 2013 & 2016

Access and curiosity have increased



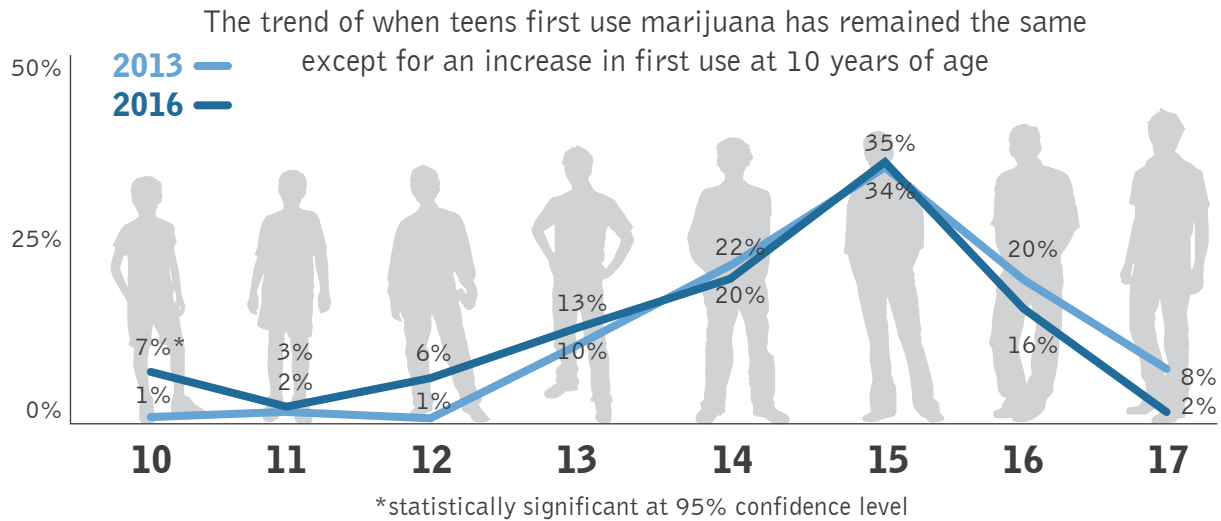
